century biblical hermeneutics as well as the numerous instances of prophetic eruption in romantic poetry the book culminates in close readings of works by blake hölderlin and coleridge each of these writers interpreted the bible in strong variously radical and conservative ways and each reworked prophetic texts in often startling fashion the author s reading of blake focuses on the complex temporal and rhetorical dynamics at work in a prophetic tradition with attention paid to the key mediating figure of milton the chapter on hölderlin investigates the truth claim of poetry and the consequences of hölderlin s insight into the necessarily figural character of poetry the analysis of coleridge correlates his theory of allegory and symbol with his theory and practice of political writing which often relies on mobilizing prophetic authority together the readings force us to reexamine the claims and practices of romantic poets and thinkers and their ideas and ideologies not without engendering some allegorical resonance with issues in our own time
